Many children and their families looked forward to the first day of school. The staff came in August so the children could drop off supplies, meet their teacher and see their classroom. The staff were smiling and ready to


greet them all and help them transition into their new experiences at school. It is magical to see the ways the teachers turned those that were teary into smiling playmates. The children have adjusted nicely.


